

# Christmas Tic-Tac-Toe

a game for two players

The object of Christmas Tic-Tac-Toe is to be the first player to place three of their playing pieces in a row on the game board. Pieces may be horizontal, diagonal, or vertical.

This game is for two players. Each player selects a playing piece. The first player places their playing piece on an empty square on the game board. Next, the second player places a piece on the game board. Players then take alternate turns placing one piece at a time on the board until one player is able to place three pieces on the board horizontally, diagonally, or vertically.

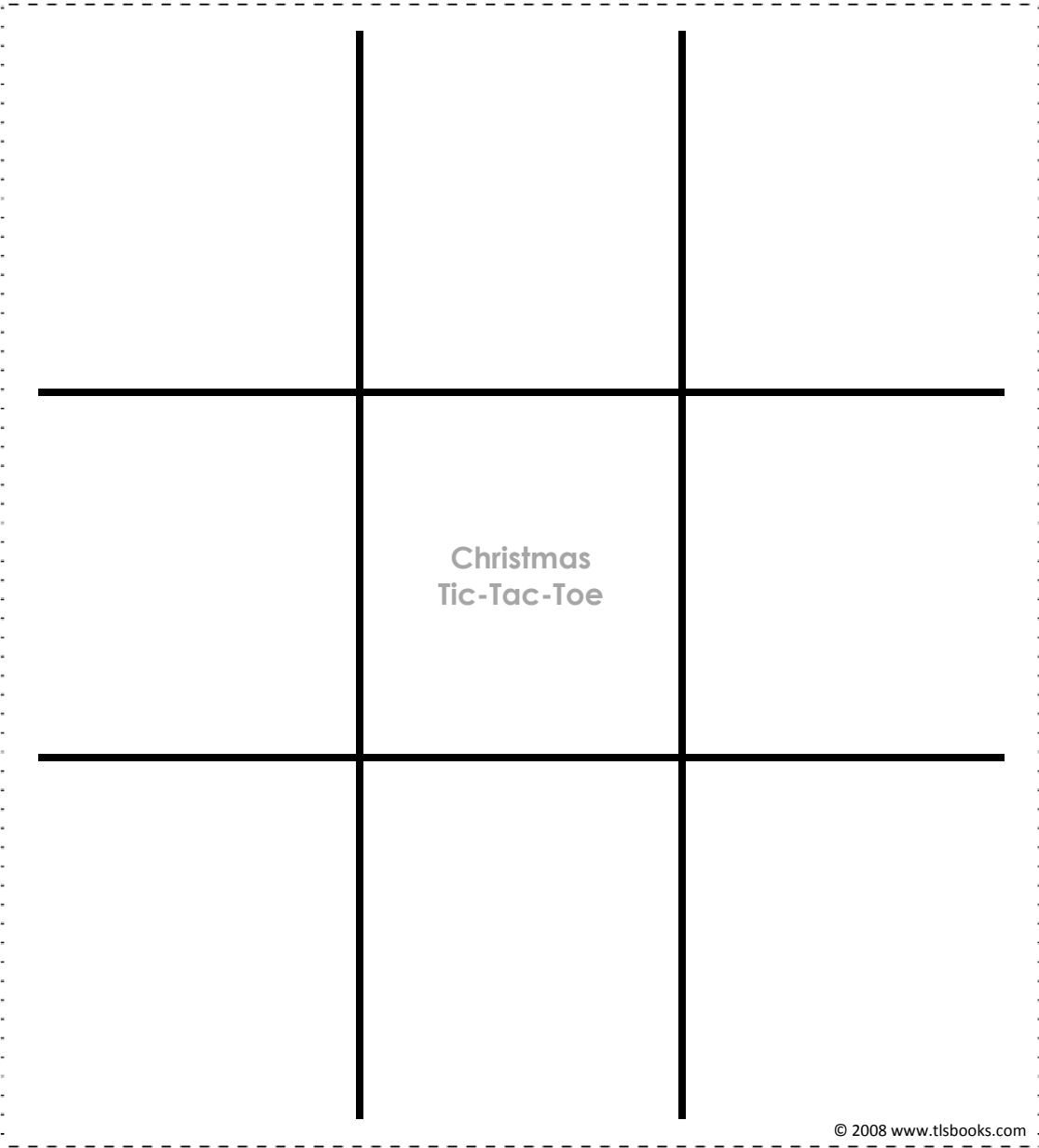
The player who is able to place three playing pieces in a row first wins!

Game assembly.

1. Let children color the game pieces.
2. Laminate the game pieces and the game board.
3. Cut out each game piece along the dotted lines.
4. Cut out the game board along the dotted lines.
5. Store pieces in a zip-lock bag.
6. If necessary, you can laminate the instructions as well and store them with the game.
