$$\begin{array}{r} 29 \\ 17 \\ + 9 \\ \hline 55 \end{array}$$

- Cassandra made seventeen plaid potholders, fifteen striped potholders, and nine solid-colored potholders. How many potholders did Cassandra make altogether?

$$\begin{array}{r} 17 \\ 15 \\ + 9 \\ \hline 41 \end{array}$$
 Cassandra made 41 potholders altogether.
- Rover has five chew toys, three squeaky toys, and three stuffed toys. How many dog toys does Rover have altogether?

$$\begin{array}{r} 5 \\ 3 \\ + 3 \\ \hline 11 \end{array}$$
 Rover has 11 dog toys altogether.
- Last week Charlie read seventy-two pages on Monday, sixty-four pages on Wednesday, and one hundred nine pages on Saturday. How many pages did Charlie read last week?

$$\begin{array}{r} 13 \\ 17 \\ + 24 \\ \hline 54 \end{array}$$
 Ione has 54 shells in her collection.
- Sean had a summer job mowing lawns. He mowed six lawns in June, nine lawns in July, and eight lawns in August. How many laws did Sean mow over the summer?

$$\begin{array}{r} 6 \\ 9 \\ + 8 \\ \hline 23 \end{array}$$
 Sean mowed 23 lawns over the summer.
- On Tuesday, Mrs. Grayson graded seven papers in the morning, four papers during lunch, and eleven papers after school. How many papers did Mrs. Grayson grade on Tuesday?

$$\begin{array}{r} 11 \\ 4 \\ + 7 \\ \hline 22 \end{array}$$
 Mrs. Grayson graded 22 papers on Tuesday.
- Thom drove from Phoenix to Nashville. He drove nine hundred twenty-four miles on the first day and seven hundred thirteen miles on the second day. How many miles did Thom drive in all?

$$\begin{array}{r} 924 \\ + 713 \\ \hline 1637 \end{array}$$
 Thom drove 1,637 miles in all.
